

MAKE **FLOWERS** FROM AN EGG BOX

YOU WILL NEED:

- An empty egg carton
- Paper or card
- Scissors
- A glue stick or tape
- Paints, colouring pencils or markers



HOW TO MAKE THE FLOWERS:

- Pick some wild flowers from the garden or when out walking, ask an adult for permission.
- Carefully cut similar shaped flowers from an empty egg box. Ask an adult to help.



NEXT:

- Paint the flowers. Wait for the paint to dry and then create a design with markers or pens.



- Use one or more cardboard cut-outs for the flower design.



- Make a hole in centre of the flower with a pencil and stick the cut-outs together with glue or tape.



NEXT:

- Make a thin stem by rolling card or paper and inserting it into the hole in the middle of the flower. Ask an adult to help if necessary.
