## MAKE **FLOWERS** FROM AN EGG BOX

## YOU WILL NEED:

- An empty egg carton
- Paper or card
- Scissors
- A glue stick or tape
- Paints, colouring pencils or markers



# HOW TO MAKE THE FLOWERS:

 Pick some wild flowers from the garden or when out walking, ask an adult for permission.



 Carefully cut similar shaped flowers from an empty egg box. Ask an adult to help.



## **NEXT:**

• Paint the flowers. Wait for the paint to dry and then create a design with markers or pens.



• Use one or more cardboard cut-outs for the flower design.



 Make a hole in centre of the flower with a pencil and stick the cut-outs together with glue or tape.



### **NEXT:**

 Make a thin stem by rolling card or paper and inserting it into the hole in the middle of the flower. Ask an adult to help if necessary.
